Please read **Philippians 2.1-11**

1. In Phil 2 vs 5 we are told...  
In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus:  
How can we live this out in our Church family at Hill Cliffe?

Please read **John 13.1-17**

2. In the passage from John we read that Jesus was aware of Judas' betrayal yet he didn't treat him any differently than the other disciples.  
The evening meal was in progress, and the devil had already prompted Judas, the son of Simon Iscariot, to betray Jesus.  
For he (Jesus) knew who was going to betray him, and that was why he said not every of them was clean.  
We often have difficulties dealing with relationships or situations in our life. Do we deal with them as Jesus did? How can we learn from Jesus example?
