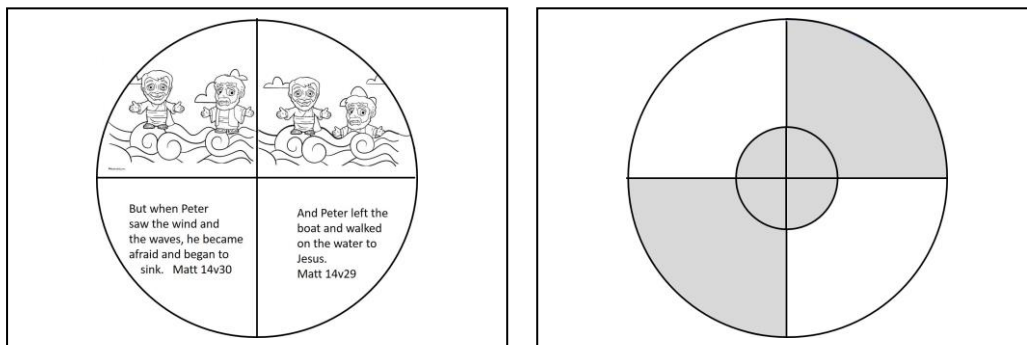


Jesus walks on water - story craft activity

In this activity you will need:

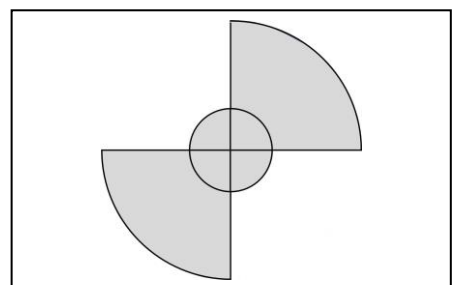
- 2 pieces of A4 thin card or thick paper
- Pair of scissors
- 1 brass split pin
- Colouring pencils or pens
- A clever mum or dad to help you with the cutting and adapting the instructions if you need help. 😊

1) Firstly, print out your templates and then colour the pictures if you want to.

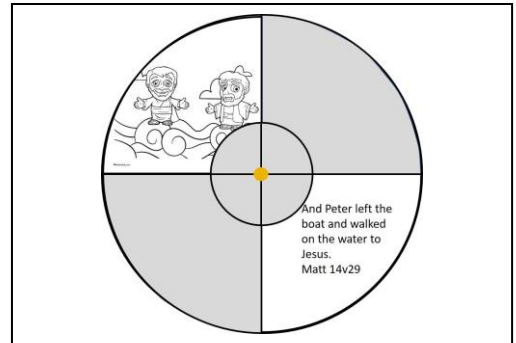


2) Now, carefully cut out the circle showing the pictures and words

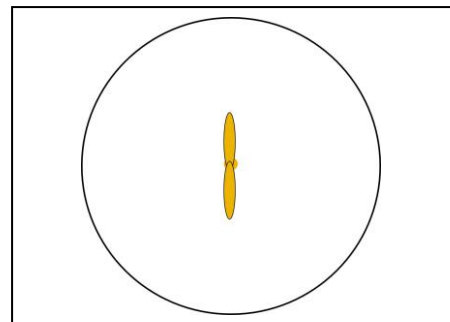
3) Now, carefully cut out the other circle. Cut out the 2 white areas on this circle.



4) **Ask mum or dad to help you with this bit.** Push the split pin through the centre of the shape and through the centre of the other circle.



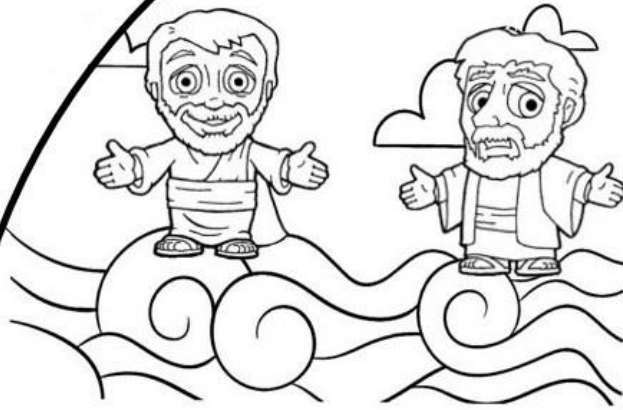
5) Turn the circles over and fold back the split pin ends.



6) Turn the circles back over. Move the top circle round to see Simon trusting Jesus and then Simon being afraid and doubting Jesus.

Read the story again in Matthew 14 v22- 33.

Ask Jesus to help you trust Him and not be afraid.
