

## Jesus heals Jairus' daughter Luke 8 v40-56

### **Message to Parents:**

This activity is taken from <https://www.jesus-without-language.net/jairus-daughter-luke-8-make-2/> The mechanism for raising the daughter is a very effective discussion point. However, I found the craft quite difficult to put together particularly gluing the bed tabs to the background picture. The instructions recommend using a craft knife to cut out the slits in the bed - I did it with sharp scissors; children might struggle with this. The bottom slit in the bed frame is a little low and I would suggest that you move it closer to the dotted line. The instructions say you don't need to cut out the middle of the table template, but you can't use the joining tab without doing this. There are meant to be dotted lines on the table, I folded the table bottom edges of the white rectangles to make the frame. Hope you have success making this model with your children.

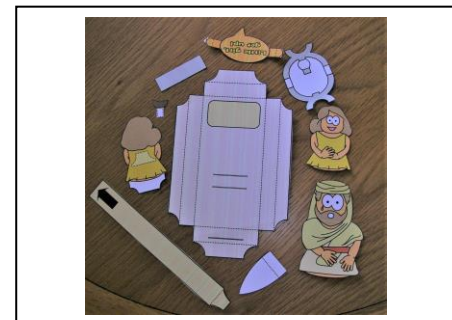
In this activity you will need:

- 2 A4 pieces of thin card
- Printed model templates
- Pair of scissors
- Glue stick
- Lots of patience
- A clever mum or dad to help you with the instructions and cutting out if you need help. 😊

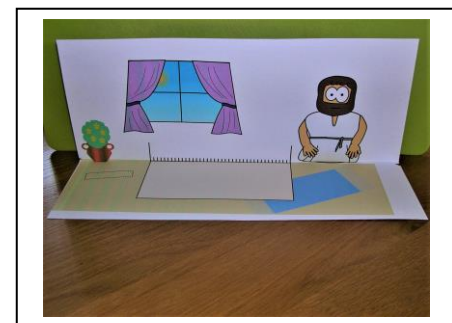
1) Firstly, print out your templates onto thin card.



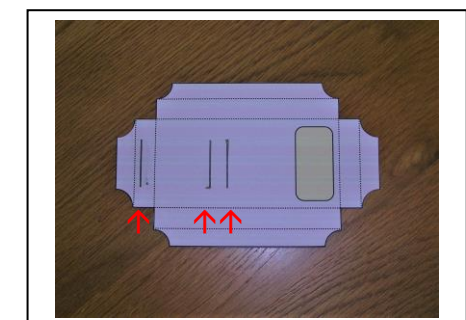
2) Now carefully cut out all the shapes. There are 10 altogether.



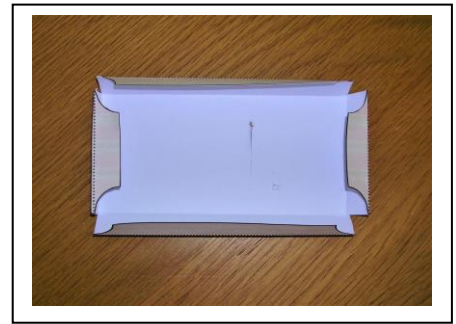
3) Take the background template and fold it along floor to wall line.



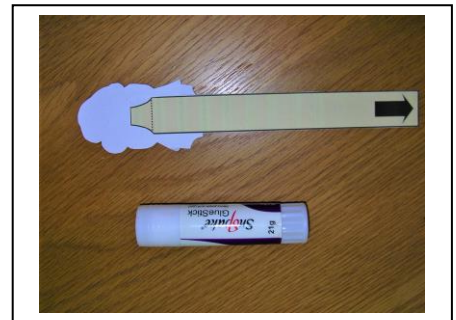
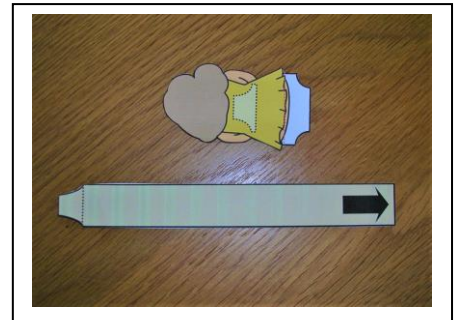
4) Now carefully cut the 3 slits in the bed template. This is a little tricky so you might want to ask mum or dad for help.



5) Turn the bed template over and fold along all the dotted lines.



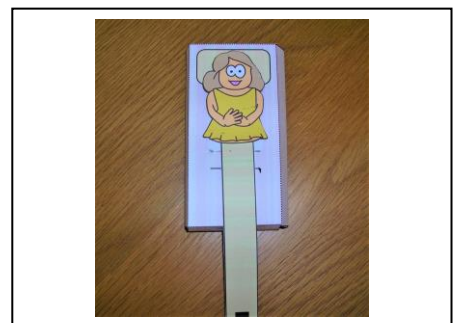
6) Take the long strip with the arrow and the back piece of the girl. Turn the girl piece face down and glue the long strip to the back of the girl piece. You should be able to see the gluing position through the card.



7) Now take the front piece of the girl; put glue only on the back of her head and glue it to the back piece.



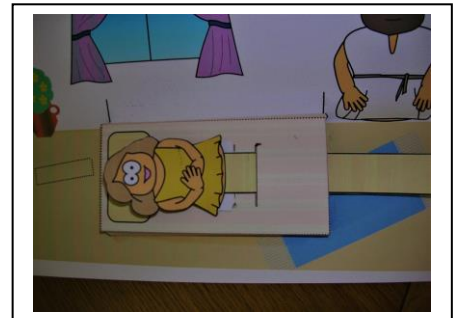
8) Fold the tab on the back of the girl. Put a little glue on the tab and then push it into the top slot on the bed. Press it firmly to stick.



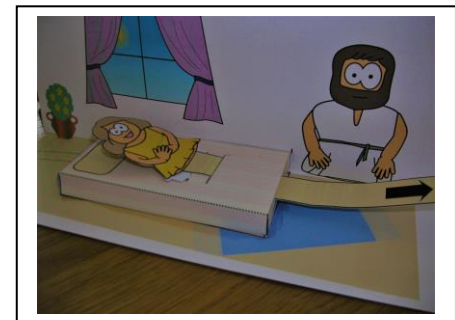
9) Now carefully slot the long strip with the arrow on the end through the second and then through the last slot, this time from the inside, so that it comes out of the bed.



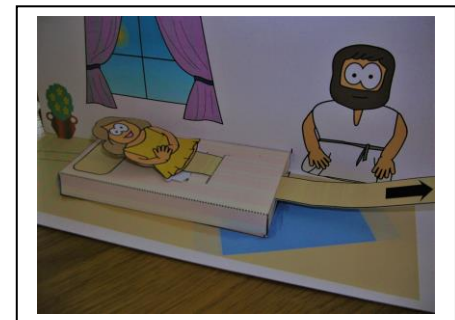
10) Fold all the side pieces inwards to make a box shape. Put some glue on the four side pieces that face down.



11) Also put some glue on the edges of the bed space on the background template. Now carefully put the bed into the space and hold until it is firm.

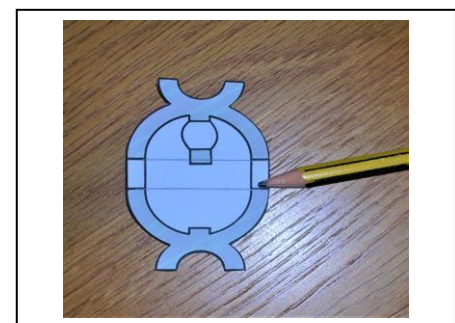


12) Put some glue on wall part of the background next to the bed and push it against the bed to hold it in place.



13) Gently pull the long strip with the arrow and the girl will sit up.

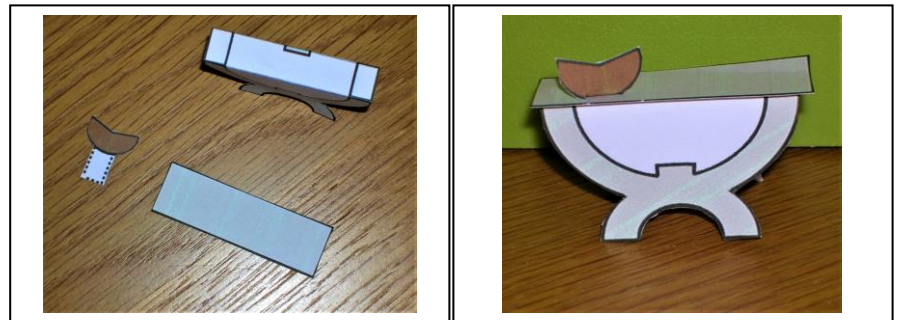
14) Take the table frame shape and draw 2 lines across in line with the white rectangles.



15) Carefully fold along the lines you have drawn to make the table shape.

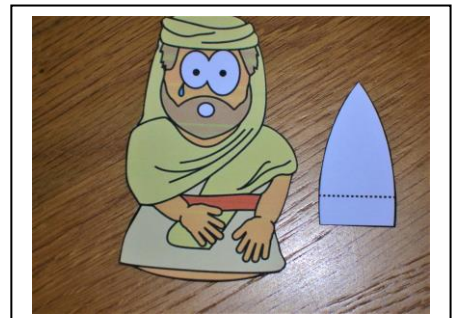


16) Take the rest of the table pieces. Stick the long piece on top of the table frame.



Then fold the tab on the bowl and glue it to the table.

17) Take the Jairus figure and the base shape. Fold on the dotted line of the base and stick the fold to the back of Jairus to make him stand up.



18) Finally assemble your model and tell the miraculous story of the Jesus healing Jairus' daughter.
