1. What does the word 'Sabbath' mean to you? What relevance do you think the Sabbath has for a 21st century Christian?

Please read Luke 6:1-5

2. What was the problem that the Pharisees had with Jesus and his disciples' actions and how did Jesus respond?
3. What did Jesus mean by saying "*The Son of Man is Lord, even over the Sabbath*"?

Please read Luke 6:6-11

4. What issue do the Pharisees raise this time? Are there times when we might act like the Pharisees?
5. In these passages, Jesus is accused of being a law breaker on two separate Sabbath days. As a Jew (and also the Messiah) what is Jesus' relationship with the Law of the Old Testament? See Galatians 3:15-22.
6. Jesus declared himself to be "Lord of the Sabbath". What does it mean for us and how can we protect The Lord's Day in our own lives?
