Week 6 – Sunday 18th October 2020 - Luke 6.12-19

Please read Luke 6.12-19

1. If you imagine yourself there in the crowds around Jesus we read of in this passage – where do you picture yourself? One of the crowd, a follower, or someone eager and ready to be called and chosen, like the apostles?
2. What do you find encouraging/challenging about Jesus' choice of these 12 men?

Judas Iscariot is a very uncomfortable choice amongst the apostles. He is also a distressing reminder to the church of the consequences of sin and betrayal of our covenant with Jesus.

3. How can we learn from this reminder, both in Judas and through Church history?

Jesus has given all of us who believe in him a Calling (**Romans 8.28-30**) and a Commission (**Matthew 28.18-20**).

4. How is God speaking to you personally about your Calling and Commission at this point in your life?
5. What do you think you need to do to get closer to Jesus so you are ready to hear his call?
6. How can you as a small group help each other in this?
