- 3. Who are the poor, bound, oppressed and blind?
- 4. How does Jesus go about fulfilling the promise of God's favour good news, freedom, and recovery in his new kingdom ministry?
- 5. What's your own experience of God's favour come to you and others you know, through Jesus and his Kingdom?

- 8. How might Christians and Churches play their part in the renewal of social justice in our society?
