Please read John 12.1-8

1. What significance do you think this scene has to the events of Holy Week? And how do Mary's attitude and actions inspire you?

This is the carefully planned announcement of God's Promised King to the City of God – Jerusalem. The scenes in Holy Week are like the OT Prophetic Announcements of God, where the words and actions are full of symbolism and meaning. The significance of his triumphal entry and the events surrounding it are rich and multi-layered. Everything is preplanned and carried out to have maximum impact.

2. Why is the donkey important to Jesus' entry into Jerusalem?
