Bible passages

From the Video - Mark 14:32-36, Daniel 3, Romans 5:3-5 Summary points

- The Bible is honest about unanswered prayer we are part of a faith that is about wrestling.
- Reasons for unanswered prayer God's world, God's war, God's will.
- God's silence is not the same as his absence.

From the Talk – Psalm 22.1-2; Matthew 27.45-46; Hebrews 4.14-16 Summary Points

- We can trust Jesus because He understands us and loves us.
- He is forever faithful to us. He calls us to be faithful to Him.
- Learning to pray is about learning to trust faithfully in His faithfulness.
