Scene 1 – Jesus Borrows a Donkey

Please read Luke 19. 29-34; John 12.14-15; Zechariah 9.9-10

3. Why has Jesus gone to the trouble of pre-arranging to borrow a young donkey to ride into Jerusalem?
4. What is the symbolic significance of him riding a young donkey? – What would it 'say' to the onlookers?

Scene 2 – The Crowd Celebrate Jesus Arrival

5. Why are the crowds treating Jesus like royalty – like a homecoming King? Does Jesus encourage or discourage this reaction?

Scene 3 – The Opposition to Jesus

Please read Luke 19.39-40

6. Why do the Pharisees react in this way?
7. What does Jesus mean about the stones crying out?

Scene 4 – Jesus Weeps Over the City

Please read Luke 19.41-44

8. Why does Jesus weep over the city? What does he foresee?

Scene 5 – Jesus Enters the City

Please read Luke 19.45-48; John 2.13-17

9. What's the significance of Jesus' actions here in the temple?
