- 1. What impacted you most from Jonathan's Sermon on Sunday?
- 2. The Christian life is intended to be a Spirit-filled and vibrant adventure of faith, but it can sometimes feel a bit 'Premier Inn'. Do you relate to Jonathan's analogy?

Please read Ezekiel 37.1-14, God's word to His desolate people in exile

The people of Israel were showing symptoms of spiritual hunger (dryness and emptiness) resulting from distance in their relationship from God.

- 3. Have you seen symptoms of this kind of spiritual hunger (apathy, shifted priorities, disordered love, living off spiritual morsels) in your life in the past or in the present?
- 4. What caused it?

This passage speaks about a 'resurrection' for the people of Israel. The way back to a spiritually satisfying renewed experience of life with God would involve <u>lament</u> (**Psalm 44.23-26**), <u>repentance</u> (turning back to God's way and away from their own bankrupt way), and a <u>hungering after God</u> (driving them towards God in his word, worship, fellowship, and prayer).

- 5. Do you have a desire for renewal in your heart at this time what are the signs of this?
- 6. What will you do about it?
- 7. What's your experience of following the above pattern of spiritual renewal (lament repentance hungering after God) in your own life?
- 8. Take time to respond to God privately, and to thank God together for God's renewal.
