1. What impacted you most from the Sermon on Sunday?

## Please read 1 John 4.16; John 13.34-35; John 15.9-12; 1 Corinthians 13. 4-8

Each of these passages describe God's special agape love – which is the character of God and is seen demonstrated in the love (agape) of Jesus.

- 2. In the Gospels, how do we see the agape love of Jesus demonstrated towards his disciples and towards others?
- 3. How is agape love different to the other kinds of love affection (Storge); or friendship (Philia); or romantic love (Eros)?
- 4. How do you feel as a disciple of Jesus about being commanded by Jesus to love one-another, and others, like Jesus loves you?

## Please read 1 John 3.1; Ephesians 3.17-19; Ephesians 5.1-2

The apostles John and Paul were captivated by the love of God, and taught about it, and prayed for it for the believers – that they might grow in the knowledge and practice of the agape love of God.

- 5. Do you feel like you are growing in your understanding and practice of the agape love of God?
- 6. We are called to Pray for this love for ourselves and for others; to Practice this love with those around us; and to Persevere in this love take some time to pray for one another inspired by Paul's prayer in Ephesians 3.17-19

In Romans 12 Paul teaches about how agape love is to be practiced in the local church. Please read Romans 12.9-19

- 7. Which aspects of practicing agape love in our own church community at Hill Cliffe do you find most challenging?
- 8. Read aloud **1 John 4.7-21**, and pray for our church family that we will pull together in the agape love of God
