
## **Prayer: Stay rooted in Christ**

## Read John 15 v 1-17

- 1. Has anyone visited a vineyard? Where and how do you think they differ to vineyards of Jesus' day?
- 2. Why do you think Jesus chose the analogy of the Vine? What did he mean when He said: "I am the Vine"?
- 3. How can we help each other to stay rooted in Christ? What practical ways can you suggest? Does prayer help us?
- 4. Read verses 4 to 9. What does "remain in me, as I remain in you" mean? How do you think we stray away from Jesus? How can we "remain in my love"? In what ways does our sin cause us to leave "His love"? Is this the pruning? How does prayer play a part in this?



- 6. Verse 14 says we should obey His commands. Which commands do you think he meant? Have a time of quiet to reflect on this and talk to Jesus asking Him for His Spirit to help you.
