Serving Together

For you have been called to live in freedom, my brothers and sisters.

But don't use your freedom to satisfy your sinful nature.

Instead, use your freedom to serve one another in love.

Galatians 5:13

1. Have you ever experienced someone serving you sacrificially, and how did it impact you?
(Sacrificially: giving something valuable (time, resources, self) for God's purpose or others' benefit, often at personal cost)
2. Read John 13 v 1-17.
What does this account reveal to us about Jesus' view of service?
3. What might hold people back from serving and how can we help one another overcome those barriers?
4. Jesus washed Judas' feet just as He did the other disciples. What does His example teach us about serving those who may have hurt us?
5. What might hold people back from asking for help/being on the receiving end of service and how can we help one another overcome those barriers?
6. How might serving alongside others build deeper relationships within the church family?
7. How can we use our unique gifts (hands, feet, eyes, etc) as the body of Christ to support/serve others in practical ways?
8. When service is difficult or discouraging, what keeps you going? (Think about v17; how has God blessed you as you serve?)
