

## Seeking God in Prayer

Small Group Notes - Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> April

Church was a bit different on Sunday and so there is no structured Bible study. Please spend this time reflecting on prayer and praying as a group. Please pray and share as you feel led and feed back to church leadership if you feel God reveals something that is for the church as a whole.

Some optional questions and prayer points are below.

**Romans 8:26–27** in the Message Bible:

26 Meanwhile, the moment we get tired in the waiting, God's Spirit is right alongside helping us along. If we don't know how or what to pray, it doesn't matter. He does our praying in and for us, making prayer out of our wordless sighs, our aching groans.

27 He knows us far better than we know ourselves, knows our pregnant condition, and keeps us present before God.

**Matthew 18 v 20** in the NIV:

For where two or three gather in my name, there I am with them.

### Optional questions

1. What are the challenges that affect you around Prayer?
2. What would you like to see more of in your Prayer life?

### Prayer points

- Thank you God that you hear us when we pray and that you can hear us even when we don't feel we have the words.
- For each other - that we would hear God, and that God would be leading us in our personal lives and as a Church community.
- Pray for Church Leadership that they would have the energy, discernment needed to make the right decisions and to lead the church with wisdom.
- For any of the different ministries of the church: Junior church, welcome team, café church, prayer team, Youth work, young adults, etc
